## IMPACTFUL CHANGES OVER 3-YEAR PARTNERSHIP




Went from the bottom 10% of performing school districts in the state of Wisconsin to the **top 50 on the DPI report card**




Parkside Elementary School went from the **6th percentile to the 78th percentile** on the DPI report card
