Matt has served in law enforcement since 1993 and has been the Sheriff of Kewaunee County since 2007. He has represented his county on several state committees, including the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, Child Death Response Task Force, and Statewide Communications Interoperability Council.

A veteran of the United States Marine Corps and a current member of the Wisconsin National Guard, Matt has advanced training in resiliency, fitness, health, and wellness. He is a certified Suicide Prevention Instructor through the QPR Institute and partners with the Center for Suicide Awareness to deliver resiliency training for first responders nationwide.

In his community, Matt teaches youth programs such as CounterACT, CORE Matters, and GRIT/SEL, and serves as a Faith Formation Teacher at Holy Rosary Parish. He is also part of the Statewide LEDR Executive Peer Support Team and helped establish a Peer-to-Peer Support program within the Kewaunee County Sheriff's Department.
